<p>MINUTES OF THE FARNDON ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 2nd APRIL 2019 AT 7.00PM, IN THE MEMORIAL HALL, FARNDON.</p>

55.19 CHAIRMAN'S REPORT.

The Chairman read the report to Councillors.

56.19 OPEN FORUM

Memorial Hall Committee: Mr Barry Fish and Mrs Pat Van Beke attended the meeting and gave a verbal report on behalf of the Memorial Hall Committee. Finance report to be submitted to the Annual Meeting in May. A request was made for the continued financial support of £2500 from the Parish Council.

Resolved: Noted and a grant of £2500 approved.

Farndon Primary School: Members of the public attended to raise concerns regarding traffic related issues and behaviours in the vicinity of the school presenting as a danger to pupils and the wider public.

Resolved: Noted that the Parish Council recognised Churton Road as an issue and had identified it as an initial site to deploy the new shared Ward speed gun when delivered. Volunteers from the community would be required to come forward to help with this deployment. Highways had already been requested to renew the yellow painted zig zag lines outside the school and the clerk would renew this request. It was suggested that a Committee/ action group (School/PTA/Parish Council/CWAC/Police/Parent representatives) be set up to focus specifically on addressing the concerns and Cllr Henderson volunteered to speak to the Headteacher. PCSO McKevitt to monitor the situation.

PCSO Jon Hurst took the opportunity to remind of the need to report any incidents on 101 and to advise that PCSO Rachael McKevitt would look to go into school to talk to pupils.

The meeting finished at 7.45pm and was followed by the April Parish Council meeting.
