

Deva Triathlon 2019 2nd June

The City of Chester has been selected to hold the English National Middle-Distance Triathlon Championships. The event will also be used to select the team to attend the World and European Teams.

The event is run entirely by volunteers from Chester Triathlon Club, a not for profit sports club that has over 600 members from Chester and the surrounding area.

1000 athletes are expected to attend the event and compete for the championship and get one of the coveted spots that will enable them to participate on the GB Team. The event is to be held on Sunday 2nd June and in order to ensure that the event is safe and causes minimum disruption to residents the start time will be at 07:00

The bike section on the triathlon takes the participants out through Chester on Eaton Road and returns through Aldford and Huntington onto Sandy Lane.

Closure at the junction of Sibbersfield Lane and Chester Road will allow the cyclists to have right of way as they exit Sibbersfield Lane heading back towards Chester.

A diversion route for traffic exiting Farndon via Barton Road / Sibbersfield and the reverse for traffic coming South from Chester.

There will be no restriction on traffic either side of the closure so no residents will be restricted in their access to properties.
