

PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY UPDATE

As you are probably aware, the Parish Council have applied to have the track running from Churton Road to join up with the Public Footpath which runs from Walkers Lane towards Churton registered as a PROW. Over 60 forms were received from villagers who said they had used the track on a regular basis for many years so we are optimistic our request will be granted in the not too distant future.

Taylor Wimpey have now erected a fence between the track and Shearwater Drive, which is a private road owned by the residents, so it is clear exactly where the PROW is. We would also please ask dog walkers to keep their dogs under control whilst in the vicinity of the new houses in order to safeguard their dogs from potential injury now the roads are being used and to stop their dogs from fouling the open plan gardens and driveways.

The next pathway to secure is the one that runs from Townfield Lane towards the river, ending in the field where the chalets are. There have been a couple of issues in the past and the Parish Council want to ensure the access is protected for the future.
