98.22. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs D Finlay, P Fish, J Hillyer, M Jones and M Rudd.

Resolved: that the apologies be noted.

99.22. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations of interest were made.

100.22. GENERAL PUBLIC SPEAKING TIME.

Mr Mike Dugine, CWAC Digital Specialist, attended the meeting to discuss broadband provision. He explained that it was necessary to upgrade to FTTP (Fibre to the Premises) in order to future proof homes and businesses within the village as the plan was to retire the current internet service by 2025. The Project Gigabit Voucher Scheme would mean the cost of any installation would be covered by the Government. A provider called Kloud9 intended installing a full fibre network and had asked that as many people as possible register in order to reach the minimum number required to launch the project. **Resolved:** Mike to send the Clerk a document detailing most frequently asked questions to use either in the next newsletter or in an earlier flier to be followed up with a drop-in session for residents. Mike to make contact with Cllr Rudd to answer queries raised at the last meeting.

i)Neighbourhood Pride Grant: CWAC had £2.5m to spend with £2m of that reserved for inflation costs. The other £0.5m was to be used for the grant. The suggested

ii)Riverside cliff path: Cllr Roberts reported that the contractor's solution was the same as that originally suggested by CWAC engineers and that CWAC were therefore aware that it was feasible and were still considering it. **Resolved**: Cllr Roberts to continue to raise with CWAC.
